WHAT WAS YOUR FIRST MOPS MEETING LIKE?

WHY IS MILITARY MOPS SO IMPORTANT TO YOU?

Military life has a way of bringing challenges unlike anything you think you'll experience. Marital struggles. Multiple relocations. Parenting alone. My MOPS friends went above and beyond the call of duty, helping me in practical ways, connecting me with people who would love and help me — no questions asked.

HOW HAVE YOU SEEN MOPS IMPACT YOUR MILITARY COMMUNITY?

Several years ago, many Military MOPS groups were at risk because of policy changes. However, our very supportive Chaplain advocated hard for MOPS. As a result, we have seen even more moms come to MOPS as Base Family Support services have been downsized. Military families need MOPS more than ever!

When our Chaplain was deployed, he'd receive news about moms being supported and coming to Jesus through MOPS. He was encouraged and shared it with the troops serving overseas. The MOPS impact extends beyond in ways we can't imagine!

WHY IS LEADING YOUR MOPS GROUP SO IMPORTANT TO YOU?

I think a conversation between my daughter and me will illustrate this best! As we went to the base chapel to drop off paperwork, my three-year-old asked, "Mommy, are we going to another meeting?" I cringed inside. My daughter thinks meetings are more important to me than she is! I bravely faced my fears and asked if she knew why we have so many meetings for MOPS. Her response spoke volumes:

"Yes, Mommy. It's because people need to know about Jesus. We get to help them know he loves them."

Like all good things, MOPS leadership sometimes comes at a sacrifice to my family. Yet it's been deeply rewarding, much like military life.






